## EDUCATION IN RUDN UNIVERSITY

- the best Russian and international traditions of training highly qualified specialists in an internationally oriented university

## INSTITUTES, FACULTIES AND ACADEMY

RUDN UNIVERSITY includes 17 institutes, faculties and an academy. The teaching staff consists of 2 800 full professors and lecturers. In RUDN University there are about more than 30,000 students, about 10,000 of them are foreign citizens from 161 countries of the world.

International students are organized in student councils, in charge of discipline, social education and support of their rights. RUDN University has more than 150 national student associations.

## ACADEMIC CALENDAR

The academic year consists of 2 semesters. The first semester starts on September 1st, the second semester in February.

Student vacations last 2 weeks in January-February and 10 weeks in June – August.

## UNIVERSITY CAMPUS

The student campus is located in the south-west of Moscow in a park area. It is one of the best places for studying and leisure. The dormitories are located in 5-storey, 16-storey and 18-storey buildings offering double and triple rooms. Costing varies from 980 to 3,500 USD per year including communal public services cost, water and electricity, furniture, cooking and washing facilities. The rooms have connections to the internet, satellite TV and telephone.

RUDN campus is the greenest in Russia in GreenMetric University Ranking.

RUDN campus has everything for comfortable life: disposal laundries, dry-cleaning and other atelier, barber shop and hairdressing saloons, stores and shops, post-office, banks. All student campus buildings are very close to each other.

## MEDICAL CARE

**RUDN MEDICAL CARE CENTER** takes care of students and teachers' health. The multipurpose health facility – University's Medical Center – is located in the campus to provide high qualified medical assistance:

- regular health control
- primary medical care
- laboratory and diagnostic studies
- consulting by medical specialists
- dental care
- procedure room and other.

The center is equipped with modern equipment and is provided with experienced medical staff.

## SPORTS AND LEISURE

RUDN offers halls, sports grounds for free classes in various sports: gymnastics, handball, basketball, football, etc. Tennis courts also operate on the campus.

The territory of the sports and recreation complex occupies a vast territory of 6,500 square meters: 4 football fields (two indoor), 15 tennis courts and more than 40 sports sections. All year round, regardless of weather, students can go in for sports. One of the University's traditions is to hold regular "Mini World Cups" in individual and team sports.

The campus has an international postal and telephone office, shops, more than 40 cafes offering national dishes from around the world, an international cultural center and a computer center.

## SECURITY

RUDN is equipped with a modern video surveillance system, security and automatic fire alarm. Video surveillance of the territory of RUDN is conducted 24/7. Access to all buildings is available through an electronic system.

Public order and discipline are provided by our own RUDN security department and the police station located on the campus.

## LIBRARY

The central library has a collection of about 2.5 million volumes of literature and textbooks in Russian and foreign languages. Access to all libraries is free for students.

All students are given the opportunity to prepare for classes in co-working space and computer classes.











## LANGUAGE

The language of training and international communication is Russian. International students who do not speak Russian are studying for the first year at the Faculty of Russian language and General Disciplines (preparatory/foundation course), which is one of the best in Russia. The faculty has developed a unique methodical school of teaching Russian as a foreign language: in just 10 months of study, you can learn a language at the level (B1), which allows you to study at the main faculties of the University in the same group with native speakers. According to the results of training, there is the possibility of obtaining a state certificate of proficiency in Russian.

The University has more than 70 main educational programs in foreign languages. For the students who have chosen to study in a foreign language, various short-term programs in the Russian language are offered as additional courses during the school year and summer school programs.

RUDN graduates have the opportunity to get the second specialty with a separate diploma of interpreter.

## DIGITAL PRE-UNIVERSITY FACULTY

Digital Pre-University Faculty is an international online learning model for foreign citizens according to standards of Russian universities' preparatory faculties, implemented with the use of modern remote technologies.

Digital Pre-University Faculty gives you opportunity to:

- learn Russian without leaving your country;
- get a document for admission to any university in Russia;
- get a state certificate of proficiency in Russian at the B1 level;
- get a discount on studying at the Peoples' Friendship University of Russia;
- save on tuition fees: an online program is cheaper than full-time preparatory faculty.











## VISA AND IMMIGRATION ISSUES

Students' visa is issued by Russian diplomatic missions in foreign countries on the basis of an invitation from the University for a period of up to three months.

Air tickets for the flight to Moscow are sold by all the leading airlines in the world.

Visa for the right to stay in the Russian Federation is extended annually. Residence permit in Russia will be provided on students' reporting and extended every year.

RUDN International Office provides assistance and advice on all issues.

## FINANCE

Tuition fee shall be made at the beginning of each academic year (September) to the account of RUDN University.

Tuition fee for studying at the Faculty of Russian language and general disciplines (preparatory/foundation course) is \$ 4300, \$4900 – for Philology, General Medicine, Dentistry, Linguistics.

For the citizens of CIS countries tuition fee for studying at Faculty of Russian language and general disciplines corresponds to the cost of one academic year of main educational program.

International bank located in the campus offers private accounts and other services. It is advised to have at least \$350-400 to meet monthly costs (meals, transport, clothes, personal needs, etc.).

Depending on the country, the educational documents should be notarized. The notarization of the documents is carried out before arrival at RUDN University in the country, issued the education document. The need for notarization of the documents and the type of notarization (apostille or consular legalization) should be checked with the staff of the International Students Support and Recruitment Department or online: <http://nic.gov.ru/ru/proc/lega> (information in Russian) or <http://nic.gov.ru/en/proc/nic/legalize> (information in English).









## 7 STEPS FOR ADMISSION TO RUDN

1. Choose your level of study and programs.

2. Apply for training.

The application can be submitted in person, by e-mail or online.

The application includes: a questionnaire, a copy of a passport and a copy of document on education.

If there is no document on education yet (you are completing your studies in the current year), you need to send a transcript of records for a whole period of studies.

3. Receive an official information letter from RUDN.

4. Confirm your consent to study at RUDN and pay for the contract-offer.

Payment of the offer does not guarantee admission to RUDN University and visa. If you are not granted a visa or fail a competitive selection, the amount paid under the offer agreement will be returned to you. If you are successfully enrolled at RUDN University, the amount paid under the contract-offer will be credited against payment of tuition.

5. Prepare a complete package of documents and obtain a visa.

RUDN carries out the registration of the invitation for obtaining students' visa. Depending on the country of residence, it takes from several weeks to one and a half months.

The University issues an invitation for a students' visa free.











## 7 STEPS FOR ADMISSION TO RUDN

### 6. Come to RUDN and pass the entrance exams.

If you come to RUDN University for the first time, we will meet you at the airport, bring you to the University and help you settle in the RUDN dormitory. You should inform us about your arrival date and flight number within 5-7 days. This service is provided by the University completely free of charge and does not apply to citizens of CIS countries and Europe.

Admission to the preparatory faculty takes place without examinations.

Admission for undergraduate and specialized programmes takes place under competitive selection.

### 7. Congratulations! You are recommended for enrolment!

Pay for tuition, accommodation and medical insurance.

Go through a mandatory medical examination for enrollment.

Receive an official letter for your enrollment in RUDN.

Start learning.
